

Affidavit

Under Article 10 SGB V (German Social Code, Book 5) a marriage certificate (for spouses) or a birth certificate (for children) needs to be presented if family insurance is to be verified and implemented.

I,
travelled from on and I am unable to present the documents required and neither am I able to acquire any replacements, therefore I swear upon oath that I have provided the information above to the best of my knowledge and belief, and that the information is true and that I have concealed nothing.

I am aware that an affidavit is an affirmation, punishable under Articles 156 and 161 StGB (German Criminal Code), of the accuracy of my statement. I am aware of the consequences, under criminal law, of any incorrect statement, i.e. one that that does not reflect the facts or which is incomplete, i.e. where significant facts have been concealed.

Under Article 156 StGB anyone deliberately submitting such a statement inaccurately shall be penalised by up to 3 years in prison or by a fine. Under Article 161 StGB, anyone negligently submitting such a statement inaccurately shall be penalised by up to one year in prison or by a fine.

Should any incorrect information be submitted, any benefits wrongly received shall be reclaimed!
